Pick up at Miywasin Centre – main reception area, 517 3<sup>rd</sup> Street SE between 11:00 am – 1:00 pm.

We are continuing other supports for seniors 65+ for rent supplements (max \$200/month for up to a year), grocery gift cards, punch cards for Leisure Centre/YMCA, transportation -bus pass/taxi

voucher, prescriptions, utility arrears, phone bill arrears and support with filling in forms/applications, income tax filing. These supports are available through intake only, you must book an appointment with Marlene Cadotte, BSW, RSW Counselor at Miywasin 403-526-0756.
